Minutes

Workshop

Brendan Tobin called the workshop meeting of the Commissioners to order at 7:00 pm.

In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Richard Braslow read the following statement. "Adequate notice of this meeting has been provided in accordance with the Open Meetings Act by the adoption of a schedule of meetings and notice thereof being posted in the municipal building, being filed with the municipal clerk and being transmitted to the Coaster and the Hub all within 48 hours prior to this meeting."

When the roll call was taken it showed Peter Maclearie, Mason Lewis, and Brendan Tobin were present at this workshop. Ronald Neis and Charles Bell were not at the meeting.

Peter Maclearie brought up the workers compensation loss control inspection. Mason Lewis gave the representative a tour of Northside and went through his questionnaire. The representative did have some suggestions to pull from the AmTrust Loss Control Library and pull out some forms that apply and add it to our policies. Peter Maclearie brought up the worker compensation audit and how it relates to how we count members. The auditor leans towards counting anyone who shows up once not just those who make LOSAP. The previous claims and membership count are going to drive our insurance rates up. Mason Lewis and Peter Maclearie will work with the auditor.

Brendan Tobin brought up meeting with the officers of Station 1 on Sunday. The officers of Station 1 felt they would like a commissioner at the officer meetings for each department.

Brendan Tobin brought up recent discussions with District 1 and the loss of grants for radios and exhaust systems in the bays and the lack of communication. He also brought the idea of trying to get another gear washer in Station 1. Peter Maclearie brought up the past joint meetings and discussions of getting a grant writer together and asked why District 2 was not included. Chief Ryan Cullinane said he was told they could not get the grant written in time for the deadline for the radio grant.

Peter Maclearie brought up the election. Richard Braslow brought up the mail in ballots being ordered and Mason Lewis mentioned the physical ballots are ordered and will be here in time.
