March 25, 2021 Minutes - Special Meeting

Albert Neis called the regular meeting of the Commissioners to order at 18:01, at which time the pledge to the flag was given.

In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Brendan Tobin read the following statement; “Adequate notice of this meeting has been provided in accordance with the Open Meetings Act by the adoption of a schedule of meetings and notice thereof being posted in the municipal building, being filed with the municipal clerk and being transmitted to the Hub and the Coaster all within 48 hours prior to this meeting. And posted on the website and held in accordance with an executive order in relation to virtual meetings due to the pandemic.”

When the roll call was taken, it showed commissioners Albert Neis, Brendan Tobin, Charles Bell, Peter Maclearie, and Mason Lewis at the meeting.

Chief Daniel Evankow and Ex-Chief Steve Park reviewed their proposal for changes and additional equipment to modify the truck to replace 186. Peter Maclearie thanked them for the back and forth and revisions made to their proposal prior to this meeting. He mentioned that he appreciated them reaching out to each commission individually to review their proposal and providing updates as requested. Albert Neis echoed what Commissioner Maclearie said.

Charles Bell made a motion to approve Chief Evankow’s request for an additional \$180,000 for changes and upgrades for their truck to replace 186. Brendan Tobin seconded the motion. A roll call showed all five commissioners were in favor of this motion.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made at 18:14 by Brendan Tobin with a second by Charles Bell. All commissioners were in favor of this motion.
