Workshop – Minutes - December 2, 2021

Steven Park and Peter Maclearie were sworn in before by Richard Braslow before the workshop meeting.

Albert Neis called the workshop meeting of the Commissioners to order at 19:07.

In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Albert Neis read the following statement. "Adequate notice of this meeting has been provided in accordance with the Open Meetings Act by the adoption of a schedule of meetings and notice thereof being posted in the municipal building, being filed with the municipal clerk and being transmitted to the Coaster and the Hub all within 48 hours prior to this meeting. And posted on the website and held in accordance with an executive order in relation to virtual meetings due to the pandemic."

When the roll call was taken, it showed commissioners Charles Bell, Brendan Tobin, Albert Neis, Peter Maclearie, and Mason Lewis at the meeting.

Peter Maclearie discussed the conditional approval for the budget from DCA. The final approval for our budget is pending approval of the commissioners' compensation from the town, which the town confirmed would be on next Tuesday's meeting agenda.

Brendan Tobin mentioned that the state sent a letter finally closing their investigation that has been ongoing for two years. The state said that no one could go on any call with facial hair other than an acceptable mustache. Richard Braslow and Brendan Tobin said they would reach out to sources for confirmation.

Brendan Tobin gave an update on ongoing meetings with District 1. He said there were still a lot of unknowns and a lot of work ahead, but they would continue to meet with District 1 monthly. Brendan Tobin and Peter Maclearie felt it was a productive meeting.

There was no further business to discuss; Brendan Tobin made a motion with the second by Charles Bell to adjourn at 19:16. All in favor.
